MINUTES OF THE TOWN OF SELBYVILLE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL DECEMBER 14, 2022

Mayor Murray called the Special Meeting to order at 3:30 p.m. Councilmembers Richard Duncan, Carol Cary and Clarence Tingle were in attendance. Councilman Frank Smith was absent.

The meeting was properly posted.

Mayor Murray stated that the purpose of the Special Meeting was to discuss a Resolution establishing the time for the annual Municipal Election for the Town of Selbyville as authorized by Section 6.2.1 of the Charter of the Town of Selbyville.

Council members reviewed a copy of the Resolution. Upon review, Town Manager Stacey Long realized that the hours printed on the Resolution, 10 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., were incorrect. She stated that the hours have always been 11:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. in the past. Councilwoman Cary stated that she'd like to see them changed to 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. or 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Stacey confirmed that the date of the Municipal Election is set by the Charter but that the times can be changed by the Council through a Resolution. Councilman Tingle was agreeable to the change but stated he doesn't believe it will make a significant difference in the number of voters. Councilwoman Cary suggested they add the additional two hours this year and make adjustments going forward if necessary. She stated that a decision needs to be made at today's meeting in order to meet publication deadlines.

Councilman Duncan made a motion to change the voting hours of the Municipal Election for the Town of Selbyville to 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Motion seconded by Councilwoman Cary and carried by all.

There being no other business to discuss, Councilman Duncan made a motion to adjourn the Special Meeting. Motion seconded by Councilman Tingle and carried by all.
