Meeting Minutes:

- Discussed regulations for short term rentals by the Town; developments/communities can make their own restrictions via HOA, but Town can also put regulations in place
 - Town should get their proposed regulations and rules for short term rentals in writing for Council approval; can look at similar rules and regulations by neighboring towns
- Quotes for adding the new town tagline to existing Selbyville signs (by 84 Lumber and Mumford's) came in
 - Action Item: Stacey to also get quotes for updating other smaller signs with the tagline (on Rt 54, on Rt 17, on Rt 20)
 - Option for businesses to sponsor any new signage directing people into Selbyville
 - Action Item: Chamber to check with the Southern Sussex Rotary about sign on Rt. 54
 - Other signage around town could be added/planned in 2025 for wayfinding downtown, like wayfinding to the park and library, or a self-guided walking tour of historic sites in town (can use template from Historic Walking Tour at Old Timers' Day)
 - Any new town signage for Economic Development would need to be included in
 2025 budget (February deadline) if not already covered
- 2024 Committee Accomplishments:
 - New form created and mailed with business license renewal for business spotlights
 - Town of Selbyville Facebook page created and utilized for event communications, business spotlights, town announcements, council meetings, and more



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- o Town digitizing records and finished digitizing business licensing
- Sign Code edits are complete by committee, with AECOM drafting edits for final Town Council approval in 2025
- Park Project is complete through Phase 3 and Phase 4 playground equipment for 5-12 y/o application was completed and approved, but town is now waiting for PO to be signed and then will put the equipment out to bid
- New town tagline, mission statement, and vision statement completed and approved by Town Council; in process of implementing in Town Hall and on existing signage around Selbyville. Tagline, mission statement, and vision statement added to town website.
- o Map of Selbyville made by the Chamber is complete

In Progress:

- Hometown heroes banner discussion started, but won't see movement on that project until Spring of 2025 due to Hometown Hero timeline
- Town event banners and generic Selbyville banners discussed and town is getting quotes
 - Action Item: Chamber to send sizing for our event banners and the agreement we have with towns to display them, for Selbyville to mimic or start their banner program with
- Planning for 2025:
 - Town looking into accepting online payments
 - Action Item: Chamber to send contact information for Mercantile Processing Inc., close Chamber partner
 - Prioritize expanding upon existing events in 2025
 - Trunk or Treat expansion to the park
 - Library fundraising events already in the works
 - Salem Church community events in the works
 - Expansion of Old Timers' Day into the Friday of Fathers' Day Weekend
 - Town implementation of rules and regulations for short term rentals; inspections, licensing, etc.; explore verbiage and legislation.
 - o Finalize Hometown Hero banner program
 - Plan for personnel for Economic Development on Town staff; add budget and plan for a part- or full-time person to help relieve Town staff duties or specifically cover economic development tasks
 - Compile list of vacant properties in Town for 2025 as a resource for new businesses
