To qualify, a Veteran or currently enlisted personnel, living or deceased, must have or had a familial or historical connection to Selbyville (attended school, has a relative, or served, etc.) at some point during their life. Those honored on War Memorials and Veterans recommended by the local VFW and American Legion Posts qualify as well.

The banner will be 30" x 60" heavy Sunbrella material, printed on both sides, and will display the service person's photograph, including their full name, branch of the Military and the era of service (WWI, WWII, Vietnam, etc.)

Each Banner requires the Hometown Hero Form to be filled out, a photograph of the Hero in uniform, and are accepted on a first come first served basis.
