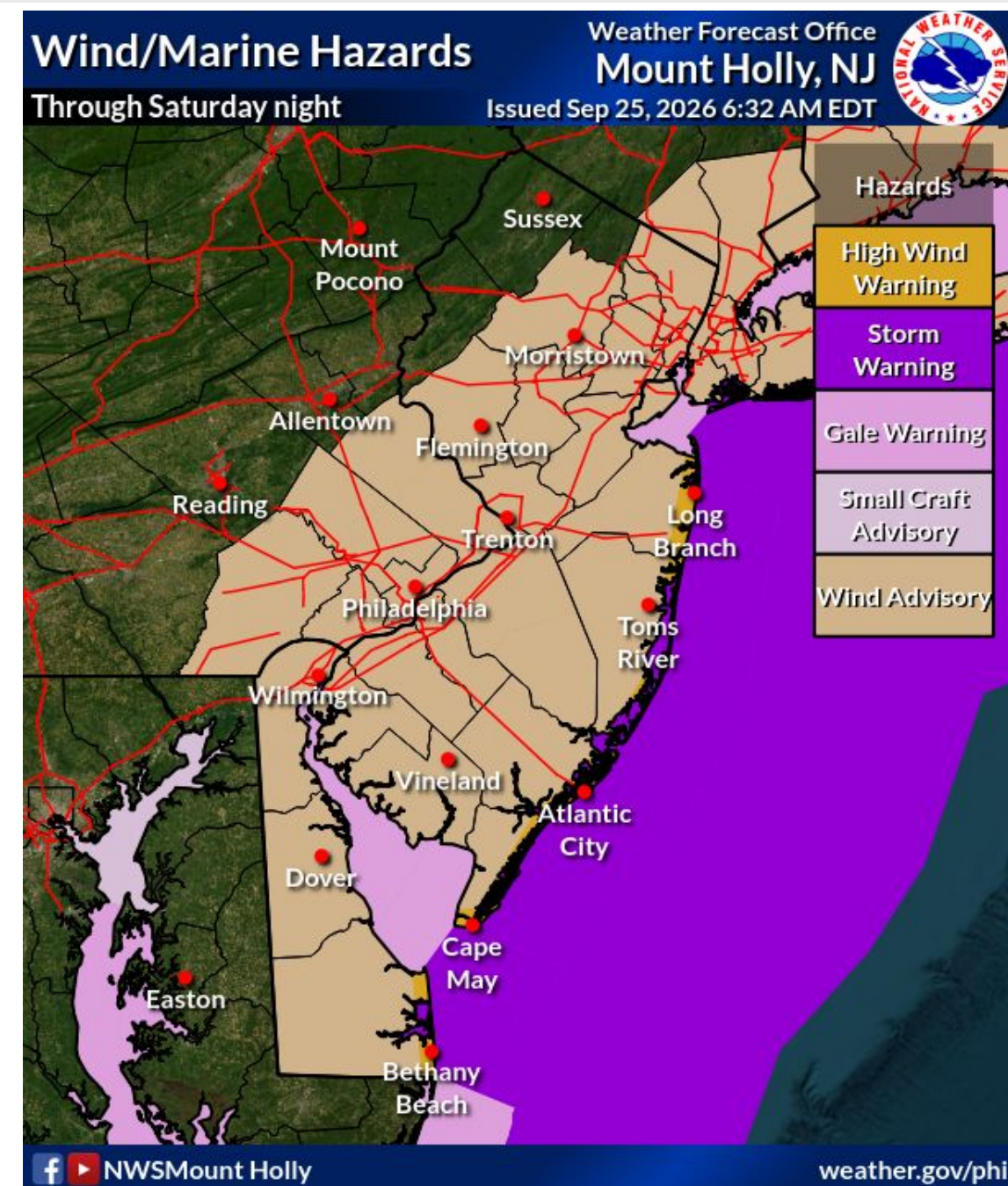

Important Updates

- High Wind Warning in effect for Atlantic coastal NJ and DE tonight through Saturday night.
- Wind Advisory in effect inland for Delaware, much of New Jersey, and portions of southeast Pennsylvania.
- Storm Warning issued for coastal Atlantic marine zones. Gale Warning in effect for Delaware Bay.
- Coastal Flood hazards extended through Saturday night for the Atlantic coast.
- Confidence in coastal and marine impacts is increasing through Saturday night, but remain lower for Sunday. Impacts will depend heavily on the exact track of a developing storm off the coast.

Key Messages

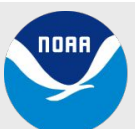
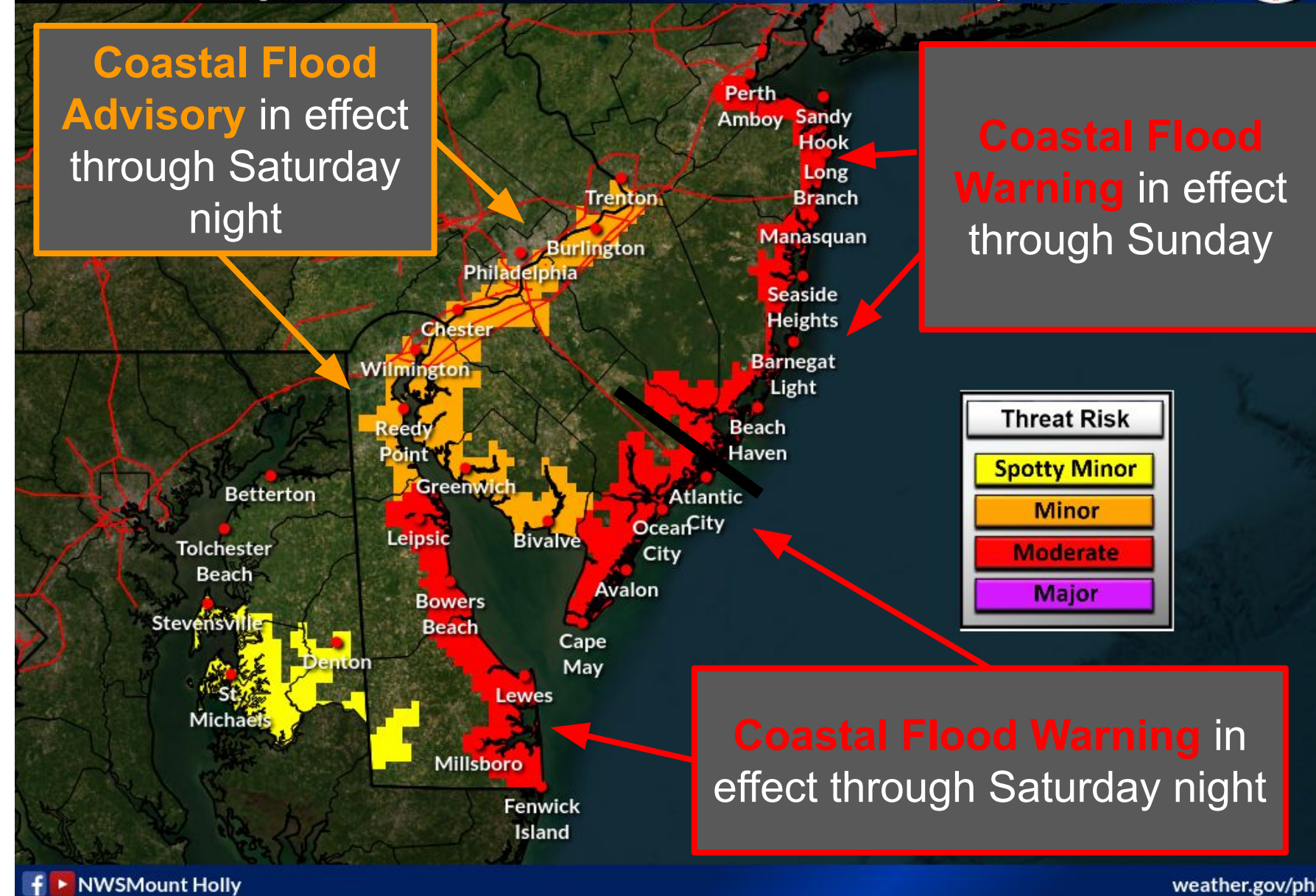
- **What:** **Minor** to **Moderate** coastal flooding expected.
- **When:** High tides through at least Saturday night, potentially lasting into Sunday, especially north of Atlantic City. Highest tides most likely to occur Saturday morning and/or Saturday night.
- **Impacts:** Potential for widespread roadway flooding in coastal and bayside areas as well as damage to vulnerable structures. Some roadways will become impassable.

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Maximum Wind Gusts

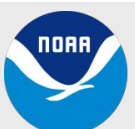
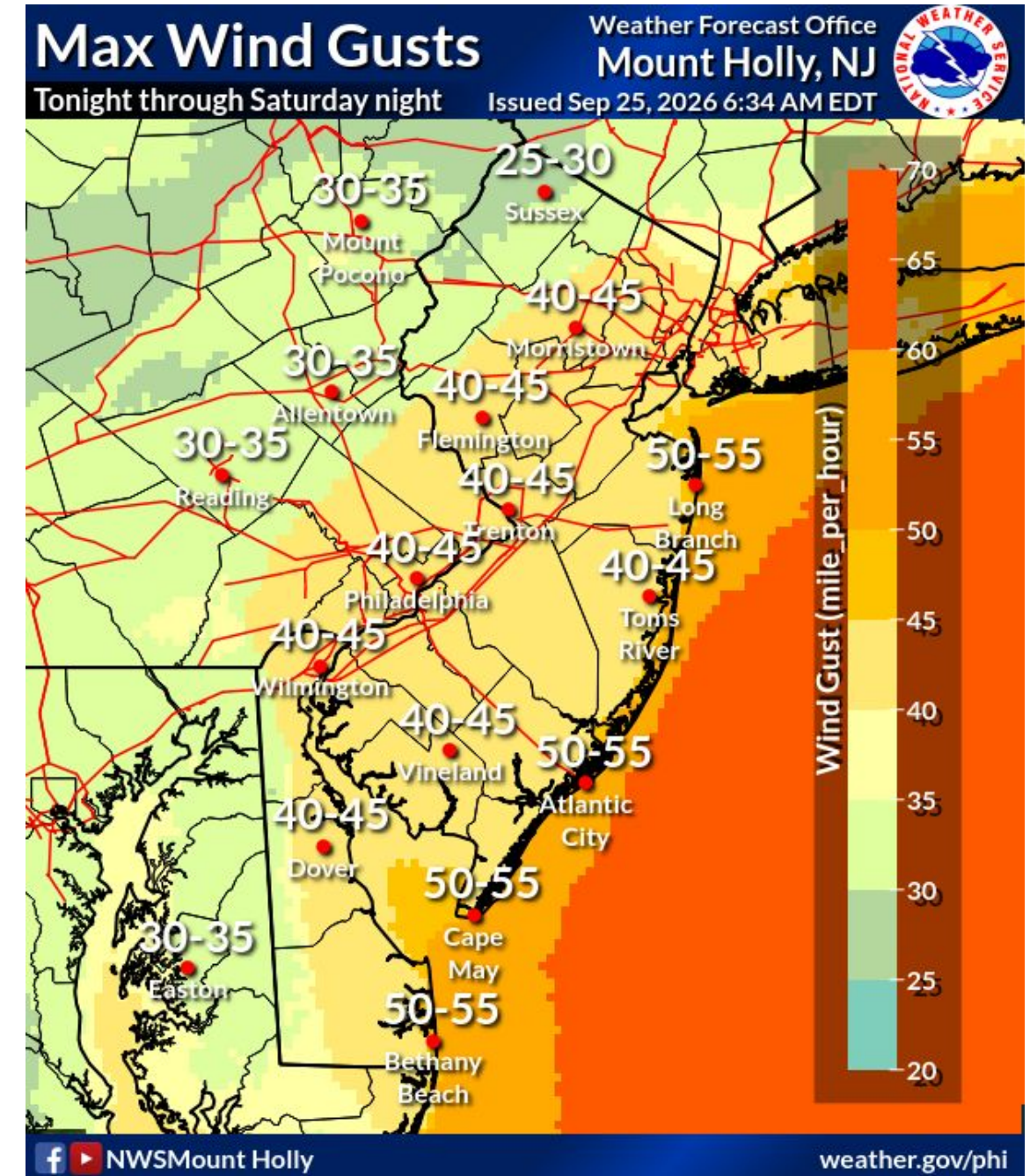

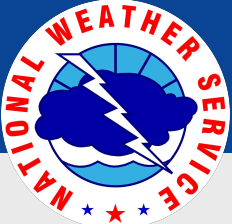
Key Messages

- Persistent north to northeast winds expected, **strongest tonight through Saturday night**, potentially lasting into Sunday near the coast.
- Along the Atlantic coasts of New Jersey and Delaware, **sustained winds near 30-40 mph with gusts up to 60 mph** (High Wind Warning in effect).
- Farther inland, wind gusts of 30-45 mph are forecast. **Wind Advisory in effect for much of New Jersey, Delaware, and portions of southeast Pennsylvania.**
- Gale force winds and gusts across all coastal waters. Seas 8-20 feet. Storm force wind gusts up to 55 kts across all Atlantic waters tonight through Saturday night.
- *Wind forecast Friday night onward remains highly uncertain.*



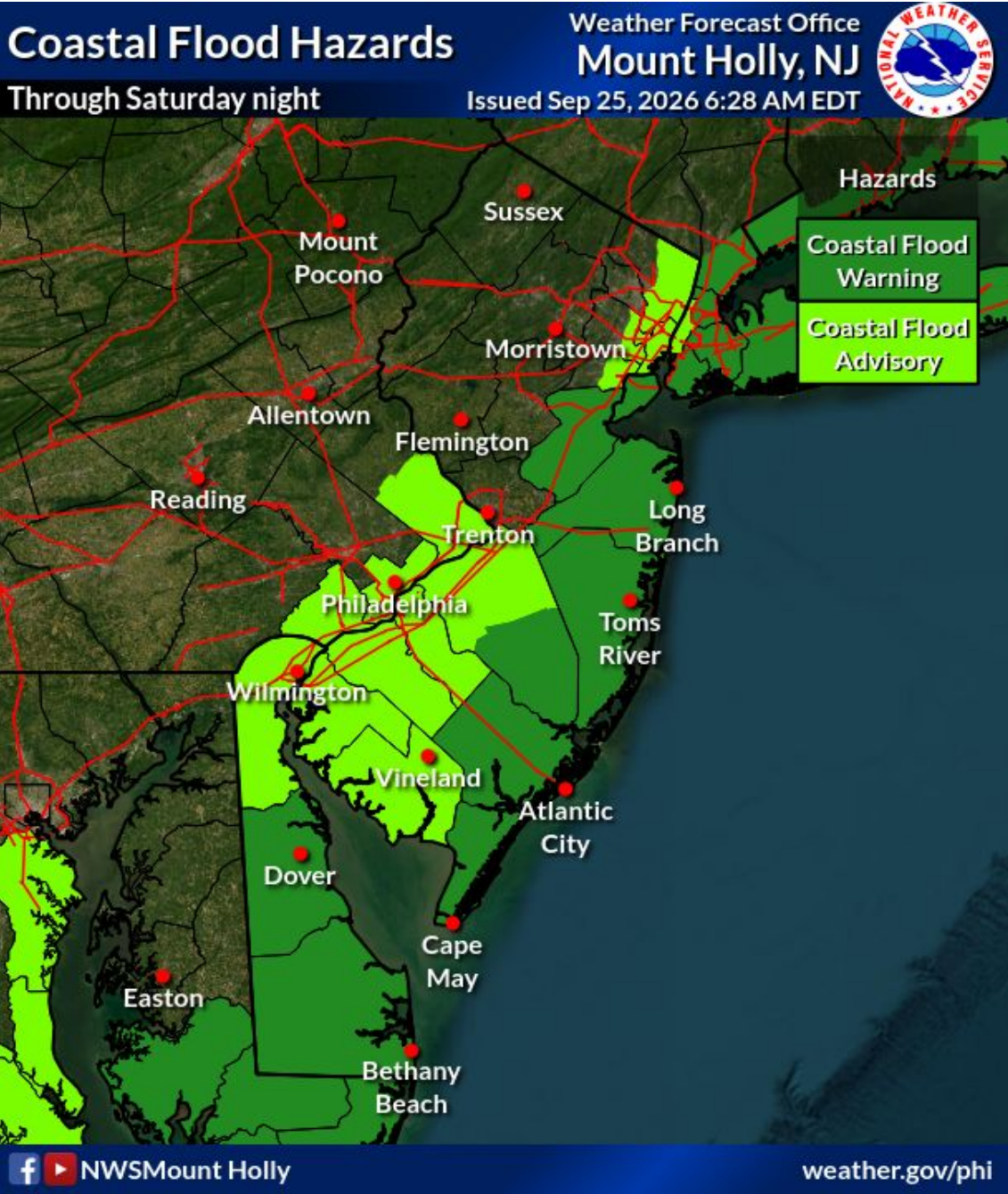
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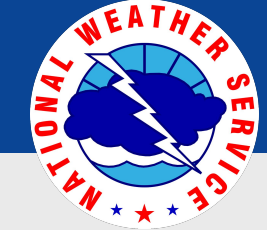

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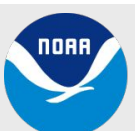


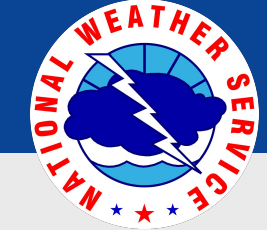


Summary of Greatest Impacts

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- **Multiple rounds of minor to moderate tidal flooding are expected into the weekend** for portions of the Atlantic coast, Delaware Bay, southern Raritan Bay, the tidal Delaware River, and Chesapeake Bay. **The most significant impacts will occur for back bay areas** including Barnegat Bay and Shrewsbury River in NJ and the Indian River Bay in DE. **The highest tides are forecast to occur during the Saturday morning and/or Saturday night high tide.**
- Windy conditions are expected on area waters and coastal areas. **Storm force winds are forecast tonight through Saturday night** for the Atlantic waters. For the Atlantic coasts of NJ and DE, a **High Wind Warning is in effect tonight through Saturday night for north winds 30-40 mph with gusts up to 60 mph possible.** A Wind Advisory is in effect for inland areas tonight through Saturday night.
- There is a **High Risk of rip currents through Sunday** as well as dangerous surf. Significant beach erosion is likely. Breaching of dunes is possible.
- Forecast confidence is high through Saturday night. **By Sunday, the forecast is much more uncertain and will depend on the track of a low developing off the coast.** If the storm tracks close to our coast, significant coastal and marine impacts may continue into Sunday along with rain and wind.
